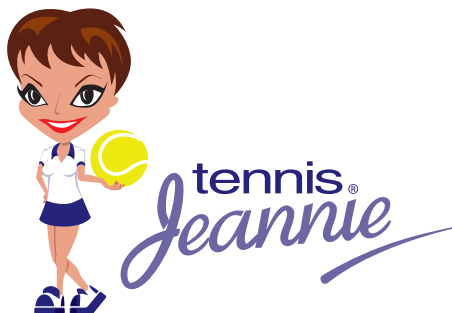

How does Jeannie work?

Simply tell me when you're available to play and I'll check other players' diaries and set up a match that's convenient for you both. I manage all communications and keep you informed of my progress. Each player has their own diary and personal message board to keep them up to date.

Court booking reminder

If you have arranged your match outside your club's court booking window, I will send you a reminder on the appropriate day.

Outlook calendar sync

You can download your match schedule into your Outlook calendar so that your tennis commitments are planned in your main diary.

What are box leagues?

A box league is a round-robin event where each player plays other players in the same box. Singles, Doubles and Mixed Double events can be organised as individual tournaments or as part of 'Grand Prix' events.

When you've played your match, let me know how you got on so that I can update the league tables. You can view league tables online and even drill down to see individual player results.

Fixture list

Your fixtures are published online. Although I am here to help you organise your matches, you may wish to contact your opponents directly. You can download a hard copy of your fixture list, which includes contact details.
